Review Questions

Q. Who was ruling over the Israelites?

A. *The Midianites.*

Q. Did the Midianites treat the Israelites with kindness?

A. *No. The Midianites stole the Israelites' food, tents, and animals.*

Q. Whom did God choose to lead Israel in defeating the Midianites?

A. *Gideon.*

Q. Was Gideon glad that God had chosen him to lead Israel?

A. *No. Gideon was angry and blamed God for Israel's circumstances.*

Q. Did God promise to help Gideon anyway?

A. *Yes.*

Q. What did the Israelite soldiers take to battle?

A. *Each soldier took a pitcher, a torch, and a trumpet..*

Q. How did the Israelites defeat the Midianites?

A. *They went into the Midianites' camp in the middle of the night, blew the trumpets, and smashed the pitchers with the torches inside. The Midianites were so afraid that they became confused and started fighting one another.*

Q. What do we learn about God from this lesson?

A. *God shows grace to his chosen people and saves them, not because they deserve it, but in order to glorify himself.*
